Decommissioning of Tornado Sirens in Canaan Township

The Canaan Township Trustees are announcing the decommissioning of the 3 Township owned tornado sirens located on W. Britton Road, E. Steiner Road, and W. Steiner Road within Canaan Township. After careful evaluation, it has been determined that the sirens will require extensive maintenance and repair costs to keep them operational. Due to the age of the sirens, their unreliability, and the high cost associated with ongoing repairs and maintenance, it is no longer financially prudent to keep them operational.

We urge all residents to utilize alternative, more reliable methods for receiving emergency alerts, such as NOAA Weather Radio, local news channels, and emergency alert apps on mobile devices. It is vital to remain informed and prepared for severe weather events.
